# Registration Instructions

## Getting Started

If you attended LC during the Spring 2007 or Summer 2007 semester and are eligible to return, follow the registration instructions listed below. If you didn't attend Louisiana College during the Spring 2007 or Summer 2007 semester, your first step is to apply for admission. If you have not applied for admission, please contact the Office of Admissions for information regarding requirements for admission to Louisiana College. In order to register for classes, you must be accepted for admission. If you are accepted for admission, you will be issued a Permit to Register. You must have your Permit to Register in order to be allowed to register for classes.

For additional information regarding admission to Louisiana College, see the Louisiana College Catalog or contact the Office of Admissions, 487-7259.

## Pre-registration

Students attending Louisiana College during the Spring 2007 semester, who are in good standing, are eligible to participate in pre-registration for the Fall 2007 semester.

1. Schedule an appointment with your advisor. Some departments may have scheduled a group advising meeting. See your advisor or department coordinator for details.
2. Meet with your advisor at the time you have scheduled to arrange your courses for the fall semester. Use the trial schedule on the inside back cover to work on your schedule with your advisor. When you have developed a satisfactory schedule, completely fill out the registration form on the back cover. Schedules will not be processed without your advisor's signature on the form.
3. You must pay the \$75 pre-registration deposit to the Business Office before your schedule will be processed. The \$75 will: (1) serve as earnest money; (2) be credited to your account; (3) be required of all pre-registered students **REGARDLESS OF FINANCIAL AID**; (4) be refunded if in excess of total bill due.
4. Bring your trial schedule, student ID, and deposit receipt to the Hixson Student Center Formal Lounge for processing according to the schedule below. This schedule is based on your **CURRENT** classification. The registration center will be open 8:30 - 11:45 a.m. and 1:00 - 4:00 p.m. during the following days.

Seniors and Freshmen	--	April 2 - April 4
Sophomores, Juniors, & others	--	April 3 - April 4

5. If you pre-register, you must finalize your registration at the beginning of the fall semester. See the next section for finalizing instructions.

## Finalizing Instructions For Pre-registered Students

If you pre-registered for the Fall 2007 semester, you must finalize your registration on August 23 according to the first letter of your last name:

1. Begin in the lobby of the Granberry Conference Center of the Hixson Student Center. You must bring your student ID card in order to complete registration.
2. Update your information sheet and fill out your insurance form.
3. Register automobile, sign up for meal plans, and confirm housing plans.
4. Return your information sheet.
5. You may make adjustments to your pre-registered schedule at this time. **If you intend to make changes, you MUST have a new trial schedule signed by your advisor!**
6. Pick up bill, check financial aid if necessary, and settle account with the Business Office.
7. Have ID card validated. **YOU MUST HAVE YOUR ID VALIDATED TO OFFICIALLY COMPLETE REGISTRATION.**

## Registration for Evening Division

If you will be taking **only** evening classes, you may register Wednesday, August 22 from 5:30 - 6:30 p.m. If you are registering at this time, have your advisor sign your trial schedule and follow steps 2 - 8 listed under "Registration for New and Non-preregistered Students" below.

## Registration For New And Non-Preregistered Students

If you are attending Louisiana College for the first time, you must attend new student orientation in order to register. For more information contact the Office of Admissions.

**No Student Will Be Allowed To Register Early.**

1. During the scheduled advising time, August 23, 8:00 a.m.- 4:30 p.m., see your advisor for help in planning your schedule. Be sure to get your advisor's signature on the registration form on the back cover of this booklet.
2. Begin in the lobby of the Granberry Conference Center of the Hixson Student Center. **Continuing students must have their ID cards in order to register.** If you were not enrolled in the Spring 2007 or Summer 2007 semester, you must present a **Permit to Register** card. If you do not have a Permit to Register, contact the Office of Admissions. Present your signed registration form to continue.
3. Update your information sheet and fill out your insurance form.
4. Register automobile, sign up for meal plans, and confirm housing plans.
5. Return your information sheet.
6. Have schedule entered into computer, pick up bill, check financial aid if necessary, and settle account with Business Office.
7. Have ID card validated. **YOU MUST HAVE YOUR ID VALIDATED TO OFFICIALLY COMPLETE REGISTRATION.** New students must have their ID cards made in the office of Student Development on the third floor of the Hixson Student Center.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

### **Cultural/Intellectual and Spiritual Enrichment Program**

The Cultural/Intellectual and Spiritual Enrichment (C.S.E.) program is considered an integral part of the educational process at Louisiana College. Participation in the C.S.E. program is required if you are registered for 9 hours or more. You must earn the required number of C.S.E. credits in order to meet graduation requirements. Please see the current Louisiana College Catalog or the Louisiana College Student Handbook for the complete C.S.E. policy.

### **Class Load**

If you register for 12 or more hours, you will be classified as a full-time student. If you register for less than 12 hours, you will be classified as a part-time student. In order to register for more than 18 hours (or 18 plus a physical education activity or music ensemble), you must have the written approval of the Vice President for Academic Affairs. The maximum course load is 21 hours. If you have financial aid, be sure to check for class load requirements.

### **Course Offerings**

The information in this booklet is as accurate as possible as of the date of publication. However, because of changing circumstances, the College reserves the right to make changes to this information as deemed necessary.

### **DIS (Directed Individual Study) Courses**

If you intend to register for a DIS course, you must complete the DIS form and return it to the Registrar's Office. Additional time is required to process DIS requests. If you return the form to the Registrar's Office by Friday, August 17, you will be able to register for the course during the regular registration process. If not, you will have to add the course during the add/drop period, August 27 - September 4. September 4 is the last day to add DIS courses. Pick up the form to register for a DIS course from the Registrar's Office.

### **Dropping and Adding Courses**

During the late registration period, August 27 - September 4, you may adjust your schedule by dropping and/or adding courses. Drop/add forms are available at the Registrar's Office. No change to your schedule is possible after September 4. If you wish to drop all courses, you must resign from the college.

### **Housing**

College housing is available for both men and women. You are expected to live on campus if you are not living at home, unless written permission has been obtained from the Office of Student Life. Contact the Director of Housing for additional information.

### **Late Registration**

If you register after Friday, August 24, you must pay a late fee of \$50. September 4 is the last date to change courses, including change from audit to credit or vice versa, pass/fail to grade or vice versa, dropping courses with a refund, dropping courses without a grade, registering for DIS courses, and processing repeat course forms. You may not register for any classes after September 4.

**Absences caused by late registration count toward the maximum allowed absences for the semester.**

### **Orientation For New Students**

If you are attending Louisiana College for the first time, you must participate in new student orientation. Orientation begins Wednesday, August 22 at 1:30 p.m. and concludes with registration on Friday, August 24. Contact the Office of Admissions for an orientation schedule. If you don't have an ACT score, the ACT Residual will be given Tuesday, August 21 at 9:00 a.m.

### Repeating a Course

If you are repeating a course that you originally took at another school, you must file a Repeat Course form with the Registrar's Office by September 4. This form may be obtained at the Registrar's Office. If a Repeat Course form is not completed and filed, the repeated courses will be averaged. The last grade earned will become the grade of record. If you are repeating a course at Louisiana College that you originally took at Louisiana College, you do NOT have to complete a Repeat Course form. Please see the current Louisiana College Catalog for the complete policy on repeating a course.

### Resignation

If you wish to drop or withdraw from all courses, you must resign from the college. An official resignation form must be processed in order to resign. If you do not officially resign, you will be considered enrolled and may receive failing grades in all classes. If you resign by September 4, you will have no courses or grades listed on your transcript. If you resign from September 5 - October 29, you will receive a grade of "W" for each course. If you resign from October 30 - November 26, you will receive a grade of "WP" (passing) or "WF" (failing) for each course. You may not resign after November 26. Resignation forms are available in the Registrar's Office. If you resign, you may be entitled to a partial refund. Check the catalog or contact the Business Office for refund information.

### Withdrawing From Courses

After September 4, you may withdraw from a course, although the course remains a part of your permanent record. You may withdraw from a course with a grade of "W" from September 5 - October 29. You may withdraw from a course with a grade of "WP" (passing) or "WF" (failing) from October 30 - November 26. You may not withdraw from courses after November 26. No refunds are given when you withdraw from a class. If you wish to withdraw from all courses, you must resign from the college.

### Title IV Financial Aid Recipients:

In accordance with the 1998 Reauthorization of the Higher Education Act of 1965, the refund policy for Title IV aid recipients has been changed to the "Return of Title IV Funds" policy. The law now defines the amount of Title IV grants and loans that the students has earned the right to use. The amount a student has earned is directly related to the length of time he or she has remained enrolled during the semester. The law requires a certain percentage of Title IV funds be returned when a student resigns before completing more than 60% of the semester for which he or she received the funds. Students receiving Title IV aid who stop attending all classes and receive all F's will be treated as unofficial resignations and may be required to pay back all or part of the aid received for that semester. **Specific information and examples regarding the Return of Title IV Funds policy are available in the Office of Student Financial Aid.**

\* Written commitments by the Financial Aid Office on Pell Grants, SEOG, church scholarships, committee grants, etc. constitute financial aid. All financial aid commitments must be finalized within 30 days of registration or the student will be withdrawn from all classes.
